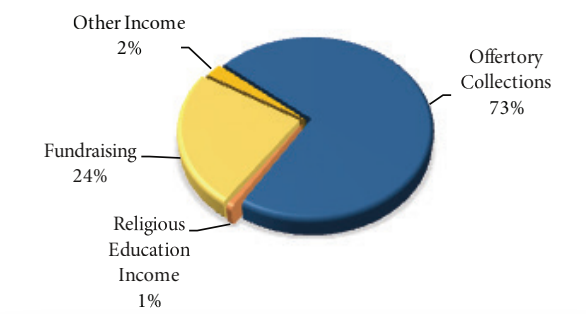


Financial Snapshot: 2023/2024 Fiscal Year

Total Operating Income \$733,895.86

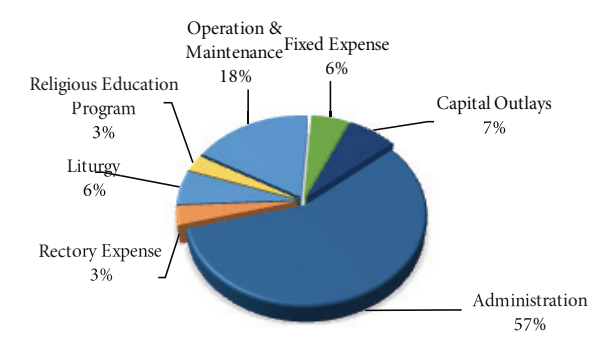
