Responding to Jesus' call to care for the most vulnerable, many parishioners volunteer at the food pantry, community meal, Christmas giving tree, and recently inaugurated clothing closet.

We also are grateful for the community life at Christ the King Parish. Events such as our Summer Picnic, St. Nicholas 5k Race, Bingo, and Christmas Cash Raffle bring people together and provide much needed income for the parish.

These costs outpace our weekly collections.


